Kansas Charters

Twenty-nine Kansas charter schools were awarded grants from money that came from the federal charter schools program between 2006-2014. At this time, at least 22 (76%) of those charter schools were closed or never opened at all.

One of the schools with the same NCES number of the awardee is currently a public school.

All findings were confirmed by searching the NCES number of the school <u>here</u> and then searching the Kansas state database of schools which you can download <u>here</u>. We also confirmed that entities had closed by checking the Center for Media and Democracy's 2015 list of closed charter schools which you can find <u>here</u>.

In total, \$6,389,964.00 was awarded to Kansas charter schools during those years that either never opened or shut down.

The chart below shows the names of charters schools in Kansas that received federal money between 2006 - 2014 but are not open today. Those highlighted in maroon are charters that opened and closed. The ones in dark maroon with white type are schools that are not currently charter schools, yet they were given CSP funds. The remaining lightly shaded entities are grant recipient schools that never opened. The federal grant amount is to the right of the school's name.
