## Louisiana Charters

One hundred and twenty-two Louisiana charter schools were awarded grants through the U.S. Department of Education's (U.S. DOE) Charter Schools Program (CSP) from money that the U.S. DOE gave to the states between 2006-2014. At this time, at least 58 (48%) of those charter schools were closed or never opened at all.

To determine that number, we compared the U.S. DOE CSP award dataset which you can find <u>here</u> with the list of open charter schools in Louisiana which you can find <u>here</u>.

Because the Louisiana Education Department does not provide a list of closed schools, we were unable to ascertain which schools never opened at all.

In total, \$26,665,973.00 were awarded to Louisiana charter schools during those years that either never opened or shut down.

The chart below shows the names of charters schools in Louisiana that received federal money between 2006 - 2014 but are not open today. The total federal grant amount is to the right of the school's name.
